

Good day care enables equal starting conditions for all Bucher children



The youth welfare office Pankow of Berlin, specialist service child day care, participates since November 2017 at the program "Kita entrance: Bridges build in early education" of the Federal Ministry for family, seniors, women and youth. Location of the project is the region Berlin Buch. The Youth Welfare Office and the partners involved - Sehstern e.V. and Vielfarb Social gGmbH - have created a coordination and network office and four specialist services for families by 2020.

By promoting the federal government, we have the opportunity to develop new offers around early education. In this way, families can be informed at an early stage and comprehensively about the day care system and its various offers. This is especially helpful for parents with language barriers or other cultural backgrounds.

In order to ensure that the offers are well coordinated and thus form bridges to the control system, they are controlled by the coordination and network office. In order to avoid duplicate structures, we also work together with other local actors, so that the different offers in the social space complement each other. Low-threshold offers such as. Family playrooms, accompaniment and assistance with familiarization, educational counseling in various languages, play and language sessions, children's visits and parents in the daycare centers - are all made possible through the support.
