

"Let's start-don't wait anymore"

Equal opportunities arise from early education, especially good day care. Unfortunately, not all families can benefit equally. Not only the shortage of skilled workers and space, but also existing access barriers are major challenges for families. Many children have to wait - sometimes for a very long time - for a daycare room.

At the location in Berlin-Buch there are currently two - in future three - accommodations for families with flight experience. As a result, the need for daycare will continue to increase significantly in the future, as families with children will primarily move in and live in the accommodation. Following the opening of the "Modular Accommodation for Refugees" (MUF) in Wolfgang-Heinz-Straße, at the end of the summer of 2017, we were able to establish a cooperation agreement with the Stephanus Foundation based on our cooperation experience with the AWO in the Refugium Berlin-Buch Close and start there with offers. There are now about 40-50 children in Kitafähigen age living here with their families in the accommodation.
